## **About Our Rovings**

Blue-Faced Leicester is a longwool breed with a staple length of 3-6", relatively fine, a fiber diameter of 56-60 count, semi-lustrous, soft, silky yarns with a beautiful drape. This is a joy to spin.

English Leicester is a longwool breed with a staple length of 6 -8", a fiber diameter of 40-46 count, lustrous, soft lamb, courser with age. Makes beautiful outer-wear and rugs. This is easy to learn to spin with because of the long staple length.

Columbia/Texel is a cross of a finer wool with a medium to course wool with a staple length of 3-5", little luster, excellent body and elasticity. The finer fleeces make an excellent choice for a wide range of knitted and woven garments. The courser fleeces are well suited for heavy outer-wear and rugs.
